## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE ATTORNEY 3 GENERAL'S STAFF STUDY CONDUCTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE 4 RESEARCH COMMISSION WITH RESPECT TO A PLAN FOR THE 5 CONSOLIDATION OF LEGAL POSITIONS WITHIN STATE GOVERNMENT.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. The Attorney General shall report to the 1989 Session of the 8 General Assembly, on or before April 15, 1989, with a plan for the consolidation of 9 legal services provided to the various departments and agencies of State government 10 consistent with the recommendations in the report of the Attorney General's Staff Study 11 Committee of the Legislative Research Commission.

12 This plan should not provide for the consolidation of the legal positions in the 13 Employment Security Commission, the Office of Administrative Hearings, the Legal 14 Staff of the Industrial Commission, the Utilities Commission Legal Staff and Public 15 Staff, the Legislative Staff, The University of North Carolina (excluding the positions at 16 North Carolina Memorial Hospital), the Administrative Office of the Courts, the Office 17 of the Governor, or the Administrative Rules Review Commission.

18 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
