A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE FLYING OF THE OFFICIAL "PRISONER OF
WAR/MISSING IN ACTION" FLAG OVER THE NORTH CAROLINA STATE
CAPITOL.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Chapter 143 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
section to read:

**"§ 143-345.9. Official 'Prisoner of War/Missing in Action' flag to be flown over the
State Capitol.**

The Department of Administration shall insure that the official 'Prisoner of
War/Missing In Action (POW/MIA)' flag is flown over the State Capitol on all State
holidays and on all days when the flying of the United States flag is required by law or
presidential proclamation."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
