- 2 AN ACT TO FACILITATE TESTING FOR COMMUNICABLE DISEASES TO
- 3 PROTECT LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
 - Section 1. Chapter 15A is amended by adding a new section to read:
- 6 "<u>§ 15A-534.3. Detention for communicable diseases.</u>
- If a judicial official conducting an initial appearance hearing finds probable cause
 that a law enforcement officer was exposed to the defendant in a manner that poses a
 significant risk of transmission of the AIDS virus or Hepatitis B, the judicial official
 shall order the defendant to be detained for a reasonable period of time, not to exceed 72
 hours, for investigation by public health officials and for testing for AIDS virus
 infection and Hepatitis B infection if required by public health officials pursuant to G.S.
 130A-144 and G.S. 130A-148."
- 14 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 1989, and shall apply to 15 acts occurring on or after that date.
