AN ACT REGARDING REAL PROPERTY TO BE PURCHASED OR RENTED THAT WAS PREVIOUSLY OCCUPIED BY A PERSON WHO DIED OR HAD A SERIOUS ILLNESS.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. Chapter 39 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
Article to read:
"ARTICLE 9.
"DISCLOSURE.
"§ 39-50. Death or illness of previous occupant.
In offering real property for sale it shall not be deemed a material fact that the real
property was occupied previously by a person who died or had a serious illness while occupying the property; provided, however, that no seller may knowingly make a false
statement regarding such past occupancy."
Sec. 2. Article 1 of Chapter 42 of the General Statutes is amended by adding
a new section to read:
"§ 42-14.1. Death or illness of previous occupant.

In offering real property for rent or lease it shall not be deemed a material fact that

the real property was occupied previously by a person who died or had a serious illness

while occupying the property; provided, however, that no landlord or lessor may

knowingly make a false statement regarding such past occupancy."

Sec. 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989, and shall apply to acts or omissions occurring on or after that date.
