11	In offering real property for sale it shall not be deemed a material fact that the real
12	property was occupied previously by a person who died or had a serious illness while
13	occupying the property; provided, however, that no seller may knowingly make a false
14	statement regarding such past occupancy."
15	Sec. 2. Article 1 of Chapter 42 of the General Statutes is amended by adding
16	a new section to read:
17	"§ 42-14.2. Death or illness of previous occupant.
18	In offering real property for rent or lease it shall not be deemed a material fact that
19	the real property was occupied previously by a person who died or had a serious illness

while occupying the property; provided, however, that no landlord or lessor may

knowingly make a false statement regarding such past occupancy."

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Sec. 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989, and shall apply to acts or omissions occurring on or after that date.
