A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE SUNDAY SALES OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT
RESTAURANTS WHICH ALSO DISPENSE MOTOR FUELS.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. G.S. 18B-1006 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
"(k) Sunday Alcoholic Beverage Restrictions. – In any city or county that
prohibits the sale of malt beverages or wine on Sundays pursuant to G.S. 18B-1004(d),
it shall be unlawful for a mixed beverage permittee who also sells motor fuels to sell
alcoholic beverages on Sunday."
Sec. 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 1989.
