A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A STATE EMPLOYEE WHO SERVES AS A  
2 MEMBER OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL BE ENTITLED TO LEAVE  
3 WITHOUT PAY FOR THE TIME THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS IN SESSION.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. Article 2 of Chapter 126 of the General Statutes is amended by  
7 adding a section to read:

8 "**§ 126-8.3. Unpaid leave for members of the General Assembly.**

9 Any permanent State employee elected to serve as a member of the General  
10 Assembly shall be granted unpaid leave for the period of time the General Assembly is  
11 in session."

12 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective upon ratification and applies to any  
13 request for leave without pay submitted on or after that date by a State employee elected  
14 to serve as a member of the General Assembly.
