The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6 7 Section 1. G.S. 20-79(d) reads as rewritten: 8 No manufacturer of or dealer in Dealer's license plates may be used on motor "(d) vehicles, trailers or semitrailers shall cause or permit any such vehicle owned by, or assigned 9 to, duly licensed motor vehicle dealers of this State when such person or by any person in 10 his employ, which is in the personal use of such person or employee, to be operated or moved 11 upon a public on the highway s of this State by the dealer, corporate officers of the 12 13 dealership, salespersons or full-time employees of the dealership, and any designated part-time employees of the dealership; with a 'dealer' plate attached to such vehicle 14 provided, the vehicle is subject to the proof of financial responsibility requirements of 15 Article 9A of this Chapter." 16 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 1989. 17
