2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE MOTOR VEHICLE DEALERS LICENSED UNDER
3 CHAPTER 20 OF THE GENERAL STATUTES TO USE DEALER
4 REGISTRATION PLATES WHILE OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE FOR
5 PERSONAL USE.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. G.S. 20-79(d) reads as rewritten:

8 "(d) No manufacturer of or dealer in Dealer's license plates may be used on motor
9 vehicles, trailers or semitrailers shall cause or permit any such vehicle owned by, or assigned
10 to, duly licensed motor vehicle dealers of this State when such person or by any person in
11 his employ, which is in the personal use of such person or employee, to be operated or moved
12 upon a public on the highway s of this State by the dealer, corporate officers of the
13 dealership, salespersons or full-time employees of the dealership, and any designated
14 part-time employees of the dealership; with a 'dealer' plate attached to such
15 vehicle provided, the vehicle is subject to the proof of financial responsibility
16 requirements of Article 9A of this Chapter. A dealership owner who desires to use
17 dealer's license plates as herein provided shall make application on forms which shall be
18 provided by the Division of Motor Vehicles and pay the sum of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for
19 the first registration and six dollars (\$6.00) for each additional registration annually."

20 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 1989.
