A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A MAGISTRATE MAY ACCEPT A WRITTEN
2 APPEARANCE, WAIVERS OF TRIAL, PLEA OF GUILTY, AND HEAR AND
3 ENTER A JUDGMENT IN A LITTER CASE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 7A-273 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

7 "(9) Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision (1) of this section,
8 to hear and enter judgment as the chief district judge shall direct in all
9 litter cases brought under G.S. 14-399, and to accept written
10 appearances, waivers of trial and pleas of guilty in violations of G.S.
11 14-399 and enter judgments in those cases as the chief district judge
12 directs."

13 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 1989.
