- 2 years of certified experience, and shall receive the salary increases necessary to bring
- them to the appropriate level on the schedule; provided, however, that no administrator 3
- 4 shall receive less than a fifty dollar (\$50.00) per month salary increase in 1990-91, and

1 no administrator's salary may be reduced as a result of the administrator's placement on

- 2 the salary schedule. A minimum of five years' experience shall be required for3 placement on the schedule.
- Enactment of this salary schedule may not be construed to diminish or rescind 4 (c) 5 additions to salary amounts provided by law for administrator participation in the Career 6 Development Pilot Program, or for an administrator's possession of an advanced 7 certificate or earned doctorate degree; nor may enactment of this salary schedule be 8 construed to diminish or rescind rights or benefits conferred upon administrators by law, 9 other than those which expressly refer to salary matters. 10 (d) The State Board of Education shall adopt rules and regulations necessary to

11 implement this act.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Education \$24,000,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year, and \$50,400,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal year, to be used for the implementation of this act.

Sec. 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
