2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF
3 ADMINISTRATION TO FUND A PILOT PROGRAM OF PROVIDING
4 HIGHWAY PLANNERS TO CERTAIN MULTI-COUNTY PLANNING
5 REGIONS.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. There is appropriated from the Highway Fund to the Department
8 of Administration \$360,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year and \$360,000 for the 1990-91
9 fiscal year to fund a pilot program of providing highway planners to certain multi-
10 county planning regions. The funds shall provide grants of \$45,000 each to Multi-
11 County Planning Regions A, B, C, D, L, P, Q, and R to employ a local highway planner
12 to assist local city and county governments in planning future highway development and
13 construction. The Department of Administration in conjunction with the Institute of
14 Governments shall establish minimum qualifications that must be met by all local
15 highway planners funded pursuant to this section. The Department of Administration
16 shall report to the General Assembly on or before the first day of the 1991 Session of
17 the General Assembly on the results of this pilot program and any recommendations for
18 continuation or expansion of the program.

19 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
