A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF DAVIE 2 3 COUNTY TO ADOPT AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS OR PELLET GUNS FROM THE ROADWAYS AND RIGHTS-OF-4 WAY IN DAVIE COUNTY, AND TO AUTHORIZE THE DAVIE COUNTY 5 BOARD OF EDUCATION TO CONVEY OR RELEASE ANY REMAINING 6 7 INTERESTS IN CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY. 8 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 9 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law, including G.S. 153A-129 and Article 22 of Chapter 113 of the General Statutes, the Board of 10 Commissioners of Davie County may enact an ordinance prohibiting the discharge of 11 any firearm or pellet gun from, on, across, or over the roadway or right-of-way of any 12 public road, street, or highway in Davie County, except when used in defense of person 13 or property, or when used pursuant to lawful directions of law enforcement officers. 14 Sec. 2. Any ordinance adopted by the county pursuant to this act may 15 provide for fines and penalties for violation of the ordinance pursuant to the provisions 16 17 of G.S. 153A-123, and any such ordinance shall be enforceable by law enforcement officers of the Wildlife Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by 18 19 other peace officers with general subject matter jurisdiction. 20 Sec. 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Davie County Board

21 of Education may convey or release by good and sufficient deed at private sale, with or without monetary consideration, any or all remaining property interests it possesses in 22
