A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE TOWN OF LONG BEACH ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL COMMISSION FROM A CHAIRMAN AND TWO MEMBERS TO A CHAIRMAN AND FOUR MEMBERS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 4 of Chapter 345 of the 1961 Session Laws reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 4. If the operation of town alcoholic beverage control stores is authorized under the provisions of this act, the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Long Beach shall immediately create a Town Board of Alcoholic Control to be composed of a chairman and ~~two~~ four other members who shall be well known for their character, ability and business acumen. Said board shall be known and designated as 'The Town of Long Beach Board of Alcoholic Control'. ~~The members and chairman of said board shall be designated by the mayor and governing body of the town and the member designated as chairman shall serve for his first term a period of three years. As to the other members, one member shall serve for his first term a period of two years and the other member shall serve for his first term a period of one year; and all terms shall begin with the date of their appointment. Thereafter, as the terms of the chairman and members expire, their successors in office~~ The chairman and members shall serve for terms of three years each, and until their successors are appointed and qualified. Any vacancy shall be filled by the Board of Commissioners for the unexpired term. Compensation of the members of said Town Board of Alcoholic Control shall be fixed by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Long Beach."

1 Sec. 2. To implement the increase in the membership of the board as
2 authorized by Section 1 of this act, two new members shall be appointed to the board on
3 the next date after the effective date of this act on which any position on the current
4 board is filled. On that date one new member shall be appointed for a term of two years
5 and one new member shall be appointed for a term of three years; thereafter the terms
6 for the two new members shall be for three years.

7 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
