1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO CHANGE THE COMPOSITION OF THE NORTH CAROLINA  
3 COUNCIL ON THE HOLOCAUST.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. G.S. 143B-216.21 reads as rewritten:

6 "**§ 143B-216.21. Membership; selection; quorum.**

7 The Council shall consist of 24 members, ~~eight~~six appointed by the Governor, ~~eight~~  
8 six appointed by the President of the Senate, ~~and eight~~six appointed by the Speaker of  
9 the House of Representatives, and six appointed by the other 18 members. Members  
10 shall be appointed in 1985 for two-year terms to begin July 1, 1985. In 1987 and  
11 biennially thereafter, successors shall be appointed for two-year terms. The six at-large  
12 appointments shall be made by the Council at its first meeting after July 1 of each odd-  
13 numbered year. To be eligible for appointment as an at-large member, a person must  
14 either be a survivor of the Holocaust or a first-generation lineal descendant of such  
15 person. A majority of the members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of  
16 business."

17 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective with respect to appointments made for  
18 terms beginning on or after July 1, 1989.
