A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR PROJECTS IN ANSON COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Anson County Historical Society, Incorporated, the sum of \$10,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal year to house, promote, and stabilize the historical artifact collection of the Anson County Museum.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Montgomery County Cares, Women's Crisis Council, Inc., the sum of \$5,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal year for mediation and crisis prevention activities in Anson County.

Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Anson County the sum of \$10,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal year for The Anson Rescue Squad.

Sec. 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to The J. R. Faison Community Center, Inc., the sum of \$10,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal year for community activities such as child care, youth activities, and adult continuing education.

Sec. 5. There is appropriated from the General Fund to The Anson County Education Foundation the sum of \$10,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal year to promote educational excellence in the Anson County public schools.

Sec. 6. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Anson County Arts Council, Inc., the sum of \$10,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal year for arts programming.

Sec. 7. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Anson County the sum of \$10,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal year for a senior citizens center.

Sec. 8. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Anson County the sum of \$10,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal year for a hospice.

1           Sec. 9. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Anson County the  
2 sum of \$20,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal year for the Anson County Firemen's Association  
3 to be distributed equally among the volunteer fire departments in Anson County for  
4 operating expenses and equipment.

5           Sec. 10. This act shall become effective July 1, 1990.
