11		instead appoint any resident of the county;	
12	(2)	At least two physicians one physician licensed under Chapter 90 of the	
13		General Statutes to practice medicine in North Carolina;	
14	(3)	At least one professional representative from the fields either of	
15		psychology, social work, nursing, or religion;	
16	(4)	At least one individual each each, either a primary consumer or an	
17		individual from a citizens' organization, representing the interests of or	
18		from citizens' organizations representing the interests of individuals	
19		with:	
20		a. Mental illness;	
21		b. Mental retardation; <u>and</u>	
22		e. Alcoholism; and	
23		d. Drug abuse;	
24		<u>c.</u> <u>Substance abuse.</u>
