Section 1. Article 26 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 14-196.3. Using profane language on school premises.

It shall be unlawful for any person to use any words or language of a profane, vulgar, lewd, or lascivious character, nature, or connotation on the premises of an elementary or secondary school and in the presence of a minor. This section shall not apply, however, to a student enrolled in an elementary or secondary school or to a teacher or other school employee. A violation of this section is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00), imprisonment not to exceed 30 days, or both."

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 1989, and shall apply to offenses occurring on or after that date.
