A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW ONE MEMBER OF THE STATE BOARD OF COSMETIC ART EXAMINERS TO BE A TEACHER OF COSMETIC ART.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

 Section 1. G.S. 88-13(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) The State Board of Cosmetic Art Examiners is established to consist of four members appointed by the Governor and two members appointed by the General Assembly on July 1, 1987. Five members shall be experienced, licensed cosmetologists who have practiced all branches of cosmetic art in this State for at least five years immediately preceding appointment to the Board. These Four of these members shall be free of any connection with any cosmetic art school, college, academy, or training school during their service on the Board. Of the four members appointed by the Governor, one shall be a teacher of cosmetic art currently employed as a teacher by a cosmetic art school, college, academy, or training school. The other member shall be a person who is not licensed under this Chapter and who shall represent the interest of the public at large."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification and shall apply to the first appointment made by the Governor other than appointment of the public member, following the date of ratification.
