## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- AN ACT ENABLING THE COUNTY OF NEW HANOVER TO ESTABLISH AN
  AIRPORT AUTHORITY FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF
  AIRPORT FACILITIES IN THE COUNTY OF NEW HANOVER FOR THE
  CITIZENS OF NEW HANOVER COUNTY AND VICINITY.

- 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. There is hereby created the "New Hanover County Airport 8 Authority" (for brevity hereinafter referred to as the "Airport Authority"), which shall 9 be a body corporate and politic, having the powers and jurisdiction hereinafter 10 enumerated and such other and additional powers as shall be conferred upon it by future 11 acts of the General Assembly.

12 Sec. 2. The Airport Authority shall consist of five members who shall be registered voters of New Hanover County and who shall be appointed by the New 13 Hanover County Board of Commissioners. The Airport Authority shall meet at least 14 once per month at the New Hanover County International Airport. The members of the 15 Airport Authority shall be appointed to serve for a period of four years; provided that 16 initially three members shall serve four-year terms and two members shall serve two-17 year terms and thereafter members shall serve four-year terms and any member may 18 serve a total of two successive terms, after which said member may not be reappointed 19 to the Authority except after a lapse of two years following the most recent term served 20 21 by said member. Each of the members and their successors so appointed shall take and 22 subscribe before the Clerk to the Board of Commissioners for the County of New Hanover an oath of office and file the same with the County Commissioners of New 23 Hanover County. Any member of the Airport Authority may be removed, for cause, by 24

20	(3)	Sue or be sued in the name of said Airport Authority, to acquire by	
21		purchase, lease, or otherwise and to hold lands for the purpose of	
22		constructing, maintaining or operating New Hanover County	
23		International Airport and to make such contracts and to hold such	
24		personal property as may be necessary for the exercise of the powers	
25		of said Airport Authority. Said Airport Authority may acquire by	
26		purchase, lease, or otherwise, any existing lease, leasehold right or	
27		other interest in any existing airport located in New Hanover County;

		machines, food and beverage dispensing outlets, rental car services, catering services, novelty shops, insurance sales, advertising media,	
		merchandising outlets, motels, hotels, barber shops, automobile	
		parking and storage facilities, automobile service stations, garage	
		service facilities, motion pictures, personal service establishments and	
		all other types of facilities as may be directly or indirectly related to	
		the maintenance and furnishing to the general public of a complete air	
		terminal installation;	
	(10)	Possess the same exemptions in respect to payment of taxes and	
		license fees, as provided for municipal corporations by the laws of the	
		State of North Carolina;	
	(11)	Issue revenue bonds pursuant to Article 5 of Chapter 159 of the	
		General Statutes of North Carolina;	
	(12)	Have all the same power and authority granted to cities and counties	
	(12)	pursuant to General Statutes Chapter 63, AERONAUTICS;	
	. ,	Have a corporate seal which may be altered at will.	
۸	Sec. 5. Any lands acquired, owned, controlled or occupied by said Airport		
	Authority shall, and are hereby declared to be acquired, owned, controlled and occupied for a public purpose.		
101	Sec. 6. Said Airport Authority shall make an annual report to the new		
Hanover County Board of Commissioners setting forth in detail the operations and			
transactions conducted by it pursuant to this act. Said Airport Authority shall be			
regarded as the corporate instrumentality and agent for New Hanover County for the			
purpose of operating, maintaining and developing airport facilities in New Hanover			
County, but it shall not have the power to pledge the credit of New Hanover County, or			
any subdivision thereof, or to impose any obligation upon New Hanover County or any			
subdivision thereof, except and when such power is expressly granted by statute.

If any one or more of sections, clauses, sentences or parts of this act 1 shall be adjudged invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the 2 3 remaining provisions thereof, but shall not be confined in its operation to the specific provisions held invalid, and the inapplicability or invalidity or any section, clause, 4 sentence or part of this act in one or more instances or circumstances shall not be taken 5 to affect or prejudice in any way its applicability or validity in any other instance. 6 7
