A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE VILLAGE OF MARVIN GROVE IN UNION 3 COUNTY, SUBJECT TO A REFERENDUM.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

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Section 1. The following provisions of law constitute the Charter of the Village of Marvin Grove in Union County:

"THE CHARTER OF THE VILLAGE OF MARVIN GROVE.

"CHAPTER I.

"INCORPORATION AND CORPORATE POWERS.

"Section 1.1. Incorporation and Corporate Powers. The inhabitants of the Village of Marvin Grove, which area is described in Section 2.1 below are a body corporate and politic under the name 'Village of Marvin Grove'.

Under that name they have all the powers, duties, rights, privileges, and immunities conferred and imposed upon cities by the general law of North Carolina.

"CHAPTER II. "CORPORATE BOUNDARIES.

Village Boundaries. Until modified in accordance with law, the "Sec. 2.1. boundaries of the Village of Marvin Grove are as follows: BEGINNING at a point in the North Carolina-South Carolina State Line in the center line of Six Mile Creek, said point also being corner of the Union County-Mecklenburg County line, thence in a northeasterly direction with the meanderings of Six Mile Creek to a point in the center line of Six Mile Creek, said point being a northeast corner of the Reunion Land Co.

property, thence with the Reunion Land Co. property as shown in Deed Book 394, page 23

461 Union County Registry S 3145 E 1192 ft to an iron stake, thence continuing the 1 2 Reunion Land Co. Property N 46-30 E 850 ft to an iron stake, thence S 15 E 1123 ft to 3 an iron stake being a corner of Reunion Land Co. and Lucky Realty property, thence 4 with Lucky Realty property as described in Union County Registry Deed Book 400 page 281 S 14-49 E 861.75 ft to a point common corner of the First Providence 5 6 Investors Co. property and the J.L. Crist, Jr. property, thence S 17-02-50 E 1178-53 ft to a point, a corner of the Sam W. Craver property, thence with the property line two calls 8 S 44-23-20 W 1386.72 ft to a point; and (2) S 42-41and distances as follows: (1) 9 20 ft 694.20 ft as described in Deed Book 337 page 771, to a point; thence S 42-41-20 10 W 20 W 161.56 ft to a point, thence S 85-15-45 W 475.92 ft to a point, a common corner of the B.E. Ezzell property as described in Deed Book 271 Page 698, and Lucky 11 12 Realty property as recorded in the Union County Registry Book 400 page 281, thence 13 with a line of the Ezzell property S3-26-17W 2170.69 ft to a stone by a post oak which 14 is located at a corner of Tract 2 of the property of the Reunion Land Co. as recorded in Union County Registry Book 394 page461, thence with a line of Reunion Land Co. 15 16 S49-13-39 W 578.73 ft to an iron in a line of the property conveyed to William E. 17 Ezzell by deed recorded in the Union County Registry Book 271 page 692, thence with 18 a line of the said Ezzell property N 30-09-20 W 619.43 ft to an iron located at the SE 19 corner of Lot 6 in Block C of Section 2 of Marvin Estates which is shown on the map 20 recorded in the Union County Public Registry in Plat Cabinet A, File A-33; thence 21 southwesterly in the following courses: (1) 521 ft to an old iron, (2) 396.23 ft to an old 22 iron, (3) 1417.46 ft to an old iron; thence in a northeasterly direction 292.73 ft to an old 23 iron, thence in a southerly direction 1171 ft to aniron and stone corner with Banks 24 Presbyterian Church property, thence 430.44 ft to an old stone corner, thence 685.92 ft 25 in an easterly direction to an iron and stone corner the above being the westerly 26 boundaries of the W.E. Ezzell property as described in Union County Registry Book 27 271 page 692; thence 369 ft south to a point in the center line of the intersection of 28 NCSR 1307 and NCSR 1315 (Waxhaw-Marvin and New Town Roads), thence in an 29 easterly direction with the center line of NCSR 1315 (New Town Road) to a point in the 30 center of the intersection of said road and NCSR 1309 (Crane Road), thence continuing 31 south with the center line of NCSR 1309 (Crane Road) to a nail which marks the intersection of the center line of NCSR 1309 with the southerly line of the property of 32 33 one Crane (now or formerly) and the northerly boundary of Weddington Joint Venture property as recorded in Union County Registry Book 411 page 460, thence S 86-39-16 34 35 E 1940.80 ft to an iron, thence S 65-30-16 E 616.40 ft to an iron; thence S 27-59-16 E 67.20 ft to a point in Tar Kiln Branch, thence along the northerly boundary of Lots 26, 36 37 25, and 24 of Beechwood-Phase II N 71-31-11 W 1178.98 ft as recorded in Union 38 County Plat Book B File 153B, to the northwest corner of Lot 10, Beechwood Phase 39 One, thence S 71-31-11 E 455 ft to an iron, thence S 02-55-27 W 980.23 ft, being the 40 easterly boundary of Lots 10, 9, 8, 7, Beechwood Phase I, thence S 41-16-26 W 1080.77 ft being the SE boundaries of Lots 6, 5, 4 Beechwood Phase I, thence S 42-15-20 W 41 42 375.00 ft, being the SE boundary of Lot 1, as recorded in Union County Registry Plat 43 Book B File 128B, to a point in the center line of NCSR 1307 (Bonds Grove Church Road), thence in an easterly direction with the center line of NCSR 1307 to a point in 44

the center of the intersection of said road and NC 16 (Providence Road South), thence 1 2 continuing south with the center line of NC 16 to a nail and cap set in the center line of 3 NC 16, which mail and cap is located in the line of the property of Lloyd M. Bradshaw, 4 and goes thence with the northerly boundary of the Union County Sewer Treatment 5 property S 79-25-26 W 1057.17 ft to an old iron, S 77-49-46 W 502.42 ft, S 77-52-19 6 W 387.70 ft, S 77-54-35 W 473.41 ft, S 77-32-11 W 280.46 ft, S 77-26-47 W 333.94 ft to an old iron, thence south 00-15-00 E 271.81 ft to the centerline of Still Branch in the 7 8 line of Sophie R. Goans property as recorded in Union County Registry Book 87E page 9 420, thence with Goans northern boundary eastwards to a point in the center line of Still 10 Branch; thence with the center line of Still Branch southwardly to its confluence with Twelve Mile Creek, thence down the center line of Twelve Mile Creek to the center line 11 12 of the bridge over Twelve Mile Creek at its intersection with NCSR 1301 (Waxhaw-13 Marvin Road), thence following the center line of NCSR 1301 in a northerly direction 14 to an iron at the SE corner of the William C. Sugg Jr. property, thence 1300 ft in a westerly direction, being the southern boundary of the the said Sugg property as 15 16 described in Union County Registry book 333, page 155, to the SE corner of the 17 William C. and Ernestine Sugg property, thence S 84-11-03 W 535.58 ft to an iron, 18 thence S 84-32-38 W 500.4 ft to an iron at the NE corner of the Charlotte Rifle and 19 Pistol Club, thence with the line of the Charlotte Rifle and Pistol Club property S 86-17-20 38 W 3310.59 Ft to an old iron located on the North Carolina-South Carolina State 21 Line; thence in a northwesterly direction with said North Carolina-South Carolina State 22 Line to a point in the center of NCSR 1310 (Henry Nesbitt Road), thence along the 23 center line of NCSR 1310 in an easterly direction to a point in the intersection of NCSR 24 1310 and NCSR 1307 (Waxhaw-Marvin Road), thence north with the center line of said 25 NCSR 1307 to a point being the SW corner of the H.W. Gamble property as recorded in Union County Registry Deed Book 82 page 479 and the NW corner of the William S. 26 27 Small property, thence northeast 1914 ft along the southern boundary of the said H.W. Gamble property to a point in the center of Cochrane Branch, thence in a northwesterly 28 direction along the centerline of said branch to a point in the branch being the 29 30 intersection of the branch with the Nancy Rankin property as recorded in Union County 31 Registry Deed Book 409 page 662, thence 790 ft in a southwesterly direction to an iron 32 stake in the property line of Jane Gamble Murray as recorded in Union County Registry Book 288 page 256, thence N 13-44-55 E 719.19 ft to a stone being a common corner 33 34 with the Charles McGee property and the Marjorie Ezzell Fincher property as recorded 35 in Book 271 page 689, thence running N 70-36-15 W 10 ft to a point located in the center channel of Cochrane Branch, thence with the center channel of said branch in a 36 37 northwesterly direction along the eastern boundary of the Charles McGee property as 38 described in Book 277 page 148 to an iron in the center of Cochrane Branch at the SE 39 corner of the Charles and Patricia McGee property, thence continuing 813 ft in the 40 center channel of the said branch to a spike in the branch being the common corner of the McGee and the Walter Galbraith property as described in Book 404 page 934, 41 42 thence N 72-38-16 W 743.12 ft to an iron, thence N 76-29-46 W 311.83 ft to a R.R. spike in the center of NCSR 1307, being the NE corner of the property of Bill Howard 43 as recorded in Union County Registry Plat C File 63, thence across said NCSR 1307 S 44

1 86-53-29 E 745.71 ft to a pin, thence N 64-35-00 E 493.94 ft to the center of the North 2 Carolina-South Carolina State Line, thence north along the said North Carolina-South 3 Carolina State Line to the BEGINNING.

"CHAPTER III. "GOVERNING BODY.

- "Sec. 3.1. Structure of Governing Body; Number of Members. The governing body of the Village of Marvin Grove is the Village Council, which has six members, and the Mayor.
- "Sec. 3.2. Manner of Electing Village Council. The qualified voters of the entire Village elect the members of the Village Council.
- "Sec. 3.3. Term of Office of Village Council. Three members of the Council are elected in 1991 and biennially thereafter for four-year terms.
- "Sec. 3.4. Manner of Electing Mayor; Term of Office. The qualified voters of the entire village elect the Mayor. He is elected to a two-year term of office in 1991 and biennially thereafter.

"CHAPTER IV. "ELECTIONS.

"Sec. 4.1. Conduct of Village Elections. Village Officers shall be elected on a nonpartisan basis and the results determined by a plurality as provided in G.S. 163-292.

"CHAPTER V. "ADMINISTRATION.

- "Sec. 5.1. Village to Operate Under Mayor-Council Plan. The Village of Marvin Grove operates under the Mayor-Council plan as provided in General Statutes Chapter 160A, Article 7, Part 3."
- Sec. 2. From and after the effective date of the incorporation, the citizens and property in the Village of Marvin Grove shall be subject to municipal taxes levied for the year beginning July 1, 1989, and for that purpose the Village shall obtain from Union County a record of property in the area herein incorporated which was listed for taxes as of January 1, 1989, and the businesses in the Village shall be liable for privilege license tax from the effective date of the privilege license tax ordinance.
- Sec. 2.1. The Village of Marvin Grove shall not hold an election for Village Council and Mayor in 1989. Tom Robertson is appointed Mayor to serve until the organizational meeting after the 1991 election. He shall call the initial meeting of the Village Council. Wallace Getz, Ann Ayala, Gordon Suhre, Charles Williams, Lawrence Lewis, and John Tannery are appointed to serve as members of the Village Council. At the initial meeting of the Village Council, three of them shall be chosen by lot to serve until the organizational meeting after the 1991 election, and three of them shall be chosen by lot to serve until the organizational meeting after the 1993 election.
- Sec. 3. Interim budget. The Village Council may adopt a budget ordinance for the 1989-90 fiscal year, following their qualifications for office, without having to comply with the budget preparation and adoption timetable set out in the Local Government Budget and Fiscal Control Act. If property taxes are levied for the 1989-90 fiscal year, taxes may be paid at par on face amounts within 90 days of adoption of

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the budget, and thereafter according to the schedule in G.S. 105-360 as if the taxes had been due on September 1, 1989.

- Sec. 4. Special election for approval. (a) The Union County Board of Elections shall conduct an election on November 7, 1989, for the purpose of submission to the qualified voters of the area described in Section 2.1 of the Charter of Marvin Grove, the question of whether or not such area shall be incorporated as Marvin Grove. Registration for the election shall be conducted in accordance with G.S. 163-288.2.
 - (b) In the special election, the form of the ballot shall be:
 - "[] FOR Incorporation of the Village of Marvin Grove.
 - [] AGAINST Incorporation of the Village of Marvin Grove."
- Sec. 5. If the majority of the votes cast in the special election shall not be cast "FOR Incorporation of the Village of Marvin Grove", then the Charter of the Village of Marvin Grove, as set forth in Sections 1 through 3 of this act, shall have no force and effect.
- Sec. 6. If a majority of the votes cast in the special election shall be cast "FOR Incorporation of the Village of Marvin Grove", then the Charter of the Village of Marvin Grove, as set forth in Sections 1 through 3 of this act, shall be in full force and effect from and after the date upon which a certificate of election shall have been issued by the Chairman of the Union County Board of Elections in accordance with the procedures of G.S. 163-301.
 - Sec. 7. This act is effective upon ratification.
