5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. Section 1(h) of Chapter 721, Session Laws of 1985, reads as
7	rewritten:
8	"(h) As used in this section, the term 'central business district' means the following
9	area: areas:
10	(1) That area bounded by Patton Avenue and College Street on the South,
11	Haywood Street from College Street to Battery Park Avenue and
12	Battery Park Avenue from Haywood Street to Otis Street and Otis
13	Street from Battery Park Avenue to Patton Avenue; and
14	(2) That area bounded by Haywood and Flint Streets on the West,
15	Hiawassee Street on the North, Broadway on the East and College
16	Street on the South."
17	Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
