Chapter 143B of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new 6 Article to read: 7 "ARTICLE 12. "DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND TOURISM. 8 9 "§ 143B-601. Department of Natural Resources and Tourism. There is hereby created and constituted a department known as the Department 10 of Natural Resources and Tourism with the organization, powers, and duties defined in this Chapter. 12 "§ 143B-602. Duties. 13 14 It shall be the duty of the Department: To provide for the management and protection of the State's 15 forests, parks, and recreation areas and the North Carolina 16 Zoological Park; 17 18 To provide for the management and protection of the State's wildlife resources; and 19 To provide for the promotion of travel and tourism. 20 (3)

"§ 143B-603. Functions.

1	The Department of Natural Resources and Tourism, except as otherwise
2 3	provided by Article 1 of this Chapter or by the Constitution of North Carolina, shall include:
4	(1) All of the executive functions of the State in relation to the
5	State's forests, parks, and recreation areas;
6	(2) All of the executive functions of the State in relation to the North
7	Carolina Zoological Park;
8	(3) All of the executive functions of the State in relation to wildlife
9	resources;
10	(4) All of the executive functions of the State in relation to travel, tourism,
11	and welcome centers; and
12	(5) All other functions, powers, duties and obligations as are
13	conferred by this Chapter, delegated or assigned by the Governor or
14	conferred by the Constitution and laws of this State.
15	"§ 143B-604. Head.
16	The Secretary of Natural Resources and Tourism shall be the head of the
17	Department.
18	"§ 143B-605. Organization.
19	The Department of Natural Resources and Tourism shall be organized initially to
20	include:
21	(1) The Wildlife Resources Commission;
22	(2) The Forestry Council;
23	(3) The Parks and Recreation Council;
24	(4) The North Carolina Zoological Park Council;
25	(5) The North Carolina Trails Committee; and
26	(6) The North Carolina National Park, Parkway, and Forests Development
27	Council, and
28	such divisions as may be established under the provisions of Article 1 of this Chapter.
29	"§ 143B-606. Transfers to Department of Natural Resources and Tourism.
30	(a) The Division of Forest Resources, the Division of Parks and Recreation, the
31	Wildlife Resources Commission, and the North Carolina Zoological Park of the
32	Department of Natural Resources and Community Development are transferred to the
33	Department of Natural Resources and Tourism, including their statutory authority,
34	powers, duties, functions, records, personnel, property, unexpended balances of
35	appropriations, allocations, or other funds. They shall have the same relationship to the
36	Department of Natural Resources and Tourism as they had to the Department of Natural
37	Resources and Community Development.
38	(b) The Division of Travel and Tourism, including the welcome centers, are
39	transferred from the Department of Commerce to the Department of Natural Resources
40	and Tourism, including their statutory authority, powers, duties, functions, records,
41	personnel, property, unexpended balances of appropriations, allocations, or other funds.
42	They shall have the same relationship to the Department of Natural Resources and
43	Tourism as they had to the Department of Natural Resources and Community
44	<u>Development.</u> "
