A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR A NEW ASSISTANT COUNTY  
FOREST RANGER POSITION IN RANDOLPH COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Natural Resources and Community Development, Division of Forest Resources, the sum of twenty-nine thousand four hundred fifty-two dollars (\$29,452) for the 1989-90 fiscal year and seventeen thousand four hundred two dollars (\$17,402) for the 1990-91 fiscal year to establish a new Randolph County assistant county ranger position, including the purchase of equipment and operating costs associated with the new position.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to G.S. 113-54, Randolph County shall contribute nineteen thousand six hundred forty-one dollars (\$19,641) for the 1989-90 fiscal year and eleven thousand six hundred one dollars (\$11,601) for the 1990-91 fiscal year as its county share.

Sec. 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
