1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO REVISE THE SALARY SCHEDULE FOR NONCERTIFIED PUBLIC
3 SCHOOL PERSONNEL WHO ARE CLASSIFIED AS TEACHER ASSISTANTS,
4 AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO IMPLEMENT THE REVISED
5 SCHEDULE.

6 Whereas, the salaries of teacher assistants employed by public schools are
7 significantly below those of comparable positions within the State Department of
8 Human Resources; and

9 Whereas, revisions have been made to the salary schedule that have resulted
10 in disparity in the salary schedules of noncertified personnel; and

11 Whereas, the average salary of teacher assistants is well below the State
12 allotment for teacher assistants; Now, therefore,
13 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

14 Section 1. (a) Effective July 1, 1989, the following salary schedule shall be
15 applicable to noncertified public school personnel who are classified as teacher
16 assistants:

19 (b) Salary amounts for fiscal years 1989-90 and beyond are based on State
20 salary grade 56 and shall be adjusted to reflect any across-the-board percentage increase
21 applied to State salary grade 56 in fiscal years 1989-90 and beyond.

22 (c) Teacher assistants shall be placed on the new salary schedule at the pay
23 step equivalent to current placement within the salary grade and shall receive the salary
24 increases necessary to bring them to the appropriate annual salary on the schedule.

25 (d) Additional funds shall be provided to each local administrative unit, equal
26 to one percent (1%) of the total unit allocation for teacher assistants, to provide for
27 movement on the schedule based on years of experience and additional education
28 beyond minimum job requirements.

29 (e) Longevity payments are not included in the revised salary schedule for
30 teacher assistants.

31 (f) The State Board of Education shall adopt rules necessary to implement the
32 revised salary schedule for teacher assistants.

33 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
34 Public Education \$15,184,954 for the 1989-90 fiscal year, and \$29,340,697 for the
35 1990-91 fiscal year, to be used for the implementation of this act.

36 Sec. 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
