A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE PENDER COUNTY AND SURF CITY TO COLLECT
CERTAIN FEES IN THE SAME MANNER AS AD VALOREM TAXES.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. (a) A county may provide that any fee imposed under G.S. 153A-292 may be billed with the ad valorem taxes, may be payable in the same manner as ad valorem taxes, and, in the case of nonpayment, the same remedies may be used by a county to collect such fees as are used to collect delinquent ad valorem taxes.

(b) This section applies to Pender County only.

Sec. 2. (a) A city may provide that any fee imposed under G.S. 160A-314 for the purpose of G.S. 160A-311(6) may be billed with the ad valorem taxes, may be payable in the same manner as ad valorem taxes, and, in the case of nonpayment, the same remedies may be used by a county to collect such fees as are used to collect delinquent ad valorem taxes.

(b) This section applies to Surf City only.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification and applies to fees imposed on or after July 1, 1989.
