2 AN ACT TO IMPOSE A BLOOD-ALCOHOL CONTENT ANALYSIS FEE TO BE  
3 PAID BY CERTAIN PERSONS CONVICTED OF IMPAIRED DRIVING.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. G.S. 20-179 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

6 "(u) After a conviction for impaired driving under G.S. 20-138.1, the judge shall  
7 impose a fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) on the defendant if that defendant has taken  
8 a breathalyzer test or blood test. This fee shall be collected to defray the cost of  
9 providing the equipment and analysts needed to process these tests and shall be  
10 deposited in the General Fund."

11 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 1990.
