A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE ATTORNEY
GENERAL'S STAFF STUDY CONDUCTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE
RESEARCH COMMISSION WITH RESPECT TO AN APPROPRIATED FUND
TO PAY FOR OUTSIDE COUNSEL HIRED BY THE GOVERNOR.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Attorney General shall make a recommendation to the General Assembly, on or before April 15, 1989, after consultation with and the concurrence of the Office of the Governor, for an appropriated contingency fund, to be created in the Office of the Governor, for the hiring of outside counsel to represent the Governor or heads of departments or agencies in lawsuits, when the Attorney General determines that the Attorney General's Office cannot represent these persons because a conflict exists.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
