**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO AMEND THE EXCEPTIONAL CHILDREN'S APPEALS PROCESS,  
TO PRESERVE FEDERAL FUNDS, AND TO SAVE THE STATE  
REPLACEMENT FUNDS.**

Whereas, without an amendment to the law regarding the appeals process for exceptional children, North Carolina will lose approximately five million dollars (\$5,000,000) effective July 1, 1990; and

Whereas, if these federal funds are lost, North Carolina will have to appropriate replacement funds to make up for this loss; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. This act shall be known and cited as "the Exceptional Children's Appeal Process Act of 1989."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
