## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT GRANTING GREATER LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY TO

- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
  - Section 1. G.S.113-136 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

6 "(<u>d1</u>) In addition to the enforcement authority provided elsewhere in this section

7 and by any other provisions of law, protectors shall have law enforcement authority

8 with respect to any violation of the criminal laws of the State that they shall observe or

9 <u>that shall come to their notice in the course of carrying out their primary duties and</u>

10 responsibilities. Pursuant to such authority, any protector may execute any appropriate

- 11 criminal process and, upon probable cause to believe that a criminal offense is being
- 12 <u>committed in his presence, may arrest without warrant as provided by G.S. 15A-</u> 13 401(b)."
