SENATE BILL 382

AN ACT TO EXPAND THE LIST OF OFFICES AND DEPARTMENTS  
RECEIVING SUMMER INTERNS ALLOCATED BY THE NORTH CAROLINA  
INTERNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 143B-417 reads as rewritten:

**"§ 143B-417 North Carolina Internship Council – creation; powers and duties.**

There is hereby created the North Carolina Internship Council of the Department of Administration. The North Carolina Internship Council shall have the following functions and duties:

- (1) To determine the number of student interns to be allocated to each of the following offices or departments:
  - a. Office of the Governor
  - b. Department of Administration
  - c. Department of Correction
  - d. Department of Cultural Resources
  - e. Department of Revenue
  - f. Department of Transportation
  - g. Department of Natural Resources and Community Development
  - h. Department of Commerce
  - i. Department of Crime Control and Public Safety
  - j. Department of Human Resources
  - k. Office of the Lieutenant Governor
  - l. Office of the Secretary of State
  - m. Office of the State Auditor
  - n. Office of the State Treasurer
  - o. Department of Public Education
  - p. Repealed by Session Laws 1985, c. 757, s. 162, effective July 1, 1985
  - q. Department of Agriculture
  - r. Department of Labor
  - s. Department of Insurance
  - t. Office of the Speaker of the House of Representatives
  - u. Justices of the Supreme Court and Judges of the Court of Appeals

v. Department of Community Colleges

w. Office of State Personnel

x. Office of the Senate President Pro Tempore;

- (2) To screen applications for student internships and select from these applications the recipients of student internships; and
- (3) To determine the appropriateness of proposals for projects for student interns submitted by the offices and departments enumerated in (1)."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 13th day of July, 1990.
