- 2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR WINERY SPECIAL SHOW PERMITS.
- 3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
 - Section 1. G.S. 18B-1001 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
- 5 "(12) <u>Winery Special Show Permit. A winery special show permit may be issued</u>
- 6 to the holder of a winery permit, and authorizes the permittee to give free tastings and to
- 7 sell fortified and unfortified wine at trade shows, conventions, wine festivals, or similar
- 8 events. The permit may be issued for:
- 9 <u>a.</u> <u>Restaurants;</u>
- 10 <u>b.</u> <u>Hotels; or</u>
- 11 <u>c.</u> <u>Convention Centers.</u>"
- 12 Sec. 2. G.S. 18B-902 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
- 13 "(28) <u>Winery Special Show Permit \$25.00.</u>"
- 14 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
