## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO AMEND LOAD WIDTH AND HEIGHT EXCEPTIONS TO LOADS OF
- 3 TOBACCO TRANSPORTED ON THE HIGHWAYS.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
  - Section 1. G.S. 20-116(a) reads as rewritten:

6 "(a) The total outside width of any vehicle or the load thereon shall not exceed 96

7 inches, except as otherwise provided in this section: Provided that when hogsheads of

8 tobacco are being transported, a tolerance of five-six inches shall be allowed and that

9 when sheet or bale tobacco is being transported the load does not exceed a width of 114

10 inches at the top of the load and the bottom of the load at the truck bed does not exceed

- 11 the width of 102 inches inclusive of allowance for load shifting or settling."
- 12 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
