Definitions. 7 The words and phrases defined in this section shall have the meanings indicated 8 when used in this Article, unless the context clearly requires another meaning: 'Finance officer' means the officer performing the duties of finance 9 officer of a unit of local government pursuant to G.S. 159-24 of the 10 Local Government Budget and Fiscal Control Act. 11 'Governing board' or 'board' means the governing body of a unit of 12 (2) local government. 13 'Sinking fund' means a fund held for the retirement of term bonds. 14 (3) 'Unit,' 'unit of local government,' or 'local government' means 15 (4) counties; cities, towns, and incorporated villages; sanitary districts; 16 mosquito control districts; hospital districts; metropolitan sewerage 17 districts; metropolitan water districts; county water and sewer districts; 18 and special airport districts. 19 'Utility or public service enterprise' includes: 20 (5) 21 power transmission distribution Electric and i. 22 systems; Water supply facilities and distribution systems; 23 ii.
