A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT UPON MERGER OF LOCAL SCHOOL
2 ADMINISTRATIVE UNITS IN A COUNTY, THE BOARD OF COUNTY
3 COMMISSIONERS MAY LEVY AND COLLECT A SUPPLEMENTAL
4 SCHOOL TAX WITHOUT VOTER APPROVAL IN THE GEOGRAPHIC AREA
5 ENCOMPASSED BY THE NEW SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT
6 RESULTING FROM THE MERGER.

8 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

9 Section 1. If a county school administrative unit merges with one or more
10 other school administrative units, and one of the merging school administrative units
11 has previously voted a supplemental school tax which is in effect prior to and at the time
12 of the merger, then the board of county commissioners of the county where the merger
13 takes place may levy and collect, in lieu of the supplemental tax in effect, a
14 supplemental school tax, not to exceed the rate of the supplemental tax in effect prior to
15 the merger, for the purpose provided in G.S. 115C-501(a) in the school administrative
16 unit resulting from the merger, without approval of the voters of the geographic area
17 affected by the merger.

18 Sec. 2. This act shall apply to Iredell County only and to the school
19 administrative units within that county.

20 Sec. 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
