March 30, 1989 1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA RADIO READING SERVICES. 3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 4 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North Carolina 5 Association of Radio Reading Services the sum of two hundred thousand dollars 6 (\$200,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year to expand radio reading services in North 7 Carolina, which provide reading services to the blind and visually impaired in North 8 Carolina. These funds shall be allocated as follows: 9 One hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$160,000) to expand the four 10 **(1)** existing North Carolina Radio Reading Services in terms of increasing 11 local broadcasting hours and the number of listeners served. These 12 Services are: 13 14 Western North Carolina Radio Reading Service, Inc.; a. 15 CPCC Radio, in Charlotte; b. Radio Reading Service, Inc., in Raleigh; and 16 c. Southeastern North Carolina Radio Reading Service, in 17 d. Favetteville. 18 19 Forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) to encourage the creation of radio (2)

reading services in areas presently not being served in North Carolina.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
