Short Title: Sheriff's Liability/Deputy's Act. (Public) Sponsors: Senators Plyler, Conder; Basnight, Goldston, Murphy, Odom, Raynor, Royall, Smith, and Soles. Referred to: Judiciary II. April 5, 1989 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO CLARIFY A SHERIFF'S PERSONAL LIABILITY FOR THE ACTS OF HIS DEPUTY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. A new section is added to Chapter 162 of the General Statutes to read: "§ 162.26. Responsibility for act of deputy. The sheriff shall have personal liability for an act performed by his deputy only if the act was: Within the actual scope and course of the deputy's employment and in (1) furtherance of his authorized duties as a deputy; or Performed at the direction or command of the sheriff or done in (2) accordance with the written policy of the Department; or Performed with the sheriff's personal participation in the act or his **(3)** later ratification of such act. Provided, however, that the sheriff shall have no personal liability for an act of his deputy where such deputy was acting contrary to a direct order of the sheriff. Anything to the contrary notwithstanding, this section shall not apply to actions for amercements pursuant to law." Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
