- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
  - Section 1. G.S. 1-257 reads as rewritten:

# 7 "§ 1-257. Discretion of court.

The court may refuse to render or enter a declaratory judgment or decree where such 8 9 judgment or decree, if rendered or entered, would not terminate the uncertainty or 10 controversy giving rise to the proceeding. proceeding; provided, however, that a controversy between insurance companies, arising either by direct action or by joinder 11 or intervention, with respect to which of two or more of the insurers is liable under its 12 particular policy and the insurers' respective liabilities and obligations, constitutes a 13 justiciable issue and the court shall, upon petition by one or more of the parties to the 14 15 action, render a declaratory judgment as to the liabilities and obligations of the insurers." 16 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification and applies to actions brought on 17

18 or after that date.
