A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE FEE FOR DRIVER IMPROVEMENT CLINICS AND  
TO PROVIDE THAT A PORTION OF THE FEE SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED IN  
THE LAW ENFORCEMENT RETIREMENT FUND.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 20-16(e) reads as rewritten:

"(e) The Division may conduct driver improvement clinics for the benefit of those who have been convicted of one or more violations of this Chapter. Each driver attending a driver improvement clinic shall pay a fee of ~~twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).~~ thirty-five dollars (\$35.00). The Division shall deposit ten dollars (\$10.00) of every fee collected for the driver improvement clinic to the retirement fund for law enforcement officers."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991, and applies to applications for driving improvement clinics submitted to the Division of Motor Vehicles on or after that date.
