- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
 - Section 1. G.S. 20-79.4(b) reads as rewritten:

Fees. – Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge one 7 "(b) registration plate to a recipient of the Congressional Medal of Honor, a 100% disabled 8 9 veteran, a Pearl Harbor survivor, and an ex-prisoner of war. The annual fee for a special plate issuable to an active member of the national guard is the amount of the 10 regular motor vehicle registration fee. The annual fee for a personalized plate issued 11 under this section is the amount of the regular motor vehicle registration fee plus an 12 additional twenty dollars (\$20.00). The annual fee for any other special plate listed in 13 this section is the regular motor vehicle registration fee plus an additional ten dollars 14 15 (\$10.00).

The Division shall credit one-half of the revenue derived from the additional fee collected for a personalized plate to the Recreation and Natural Heritage Trust Fund established under G.S. 113-77.7. The Division shall credit the remaining revenue derived from the additional fee collected for a personalized plate and all of the additional fee collected for any other special plate to the Special Registration Plate Fund."

22 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1992, and applies to Pearl Harbor 23 survivor license plates issued or renewed on or after that date.
