A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW STANLY COUNTY TO ACQUIRE PROPERTY FOR USE BY THE STANLY COUNTY SCHOOLS AND THE ALBEMARLE CITY SCHOOLS AND TO AUTHORIZE BOARDS OF EDUCATION IN STANLY COUNTY TO CONVEY PROPERTY TO THE COUNTY IN CONNECTION WITH IMPROVEMENTS AND REPAIR OF THE PROPERTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 2 of Chapter 885 of the 1989 Session Laws, as amended by Chapters 120 and 533 of the 1991 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

- "Sec. 2. This act applies only to Bladen, Columbus, <u>Stanly</u>, Pender, Sampson, and Richmond Counties."
- Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 115C-518 and G.S. 160A-274, a local board of education may lease or sell any of its property to the board of commissioners of the county in which the property is located for any price negotiated between the two boards.
- Sec. 3. Section 2 of this act applies only to Stanly County and to local boards of education for school administrative units in or for Stanly County. Section 2 of this act applies only to sales and leases of property in connection with additions, improvements, renovations, or repairs to the property or to some part of the property.
 - Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
