2 AN ACT TO ALLOW CERTAIN COUNTIES TO ACOUIRE PROPERTY FOR USE 3 BY CERTAIN COUNTY BOARDS OF EDUCATION AND TO AUTHORIZE CERTAIN LOCAL BOARDS OF EDUCATION TO CONVEY PROPERTY TO 4 5 THE COUNTY IN CONNECTION WITH IMPROVEMENTS AND REPAIR OF THE PROPERTY. 6 7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Section 2 of Chapter 885 of the 1989 Session Laws, as amended 8 9 by Chapters 120 and 533 of the 1991 Session Laws, reads as rewritten: "Sec. 2. This act applies only to Bladen, Cabarrus, Columbus, Pender, Richmond, 10 Rowan, Sampson, and Stanly Richmond-Counties." 11 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 115C-518 and G.S. 160A-12 274, a local board of education may lease or sell any of its property to the board of 13 14 commissioners of the county in which the property is located for any price negotiated between the two boards. 15 16 Sec. 3. Section 2 of this act applies only to Cabarrus, Rowan, and Stanly Counties and to local boards of education for school administrative units in or for 17 Cabarrus, Rowan, and Stanly Counties. Section 2 of this act applies only to sales and 18 leases of property in connection with additions, improvements, renovations, or repairs to 19 20 the property or to some part of the property. 21 Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
