#### A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT RELATING TO INVESTMENTS OF THE CITY OF WINSTON-SALEM.
- 3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

4 Section 1. The final paragraph of Section 5 of Chapter 296 of the Public-5 Local Laws of 1939, as amended by Chapter 721 of the Session Laws of 1959, Chapter 6 565 of the Session Laws of 1965, Chapter 397 of the Session Laws of 1969, and 7 Chapter 1026 of the Session Laws of 1989 is rewritten to read:

"The City of Winston-Salem, or any governing body, agency, insurance company, 8 person or other corporation contracting with the City of Winston-Salem for the 9 investment, care or administration of said fund may invest and reinvest the funds 10 constituting the said fund in one or more of the types of securities or other investments 11 authorized by State law for the State Treasurer in G.S. 147-69.2. Additionally, the City 12 of Winston-Salem or any agency, insurance company, person or other corporation 13 14 contracting with the City of Winston-Salem for the investment, care or administration of funds may invest and reinvest any of the City's employee benefits funds and risk reserve 15 funds in one or more of the types of securities or other investments authorized by State 16 17 law for the State Treasurer in G.S. 147-69.2."

18 Sec. 1.1. This act, insofar as it authorizes certain investments, amends G.S. 19 159-30 with regard to the investment of the Winston-Salem Police Officers Retirement 20 Fund, employee benefits funds and risk reserve funds of the City of Winston-Salem 21 only.
