A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE COMMUNITY COUNCIL FOR THE ARTS IN LENOIR COUNTY TO ASSIST WITH THE EXPENSE OF THE RENOVATIONS DONE TO THE HISTORIC BUILDING LISTED IN THE NATIONAL REGISTER OF HISTORIC PLACES THAT HOUSES THE ORGANIZATION AND SERVES AS A COMMUNITY ARTS AND CIVIC CENTER.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Kinston Arts Council, Inc., known as the Community Council for the Arts the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 1992-93 fiscal year to assist with the expenses of the recently completed renovations done to the historic building that houses the organization and also serves as an arts and community center for the surrounding area. The Community Council for the Arts recently received a Tower Award from the North Carolina Chapter of the American Institute of Architects for the renovations done to the historic building which is listed in both the National Register of Historic Places and the North Carolina Register of Historic Places. The Tower Award is given for excellence in the preservation, restoration, and rehabilitation of historic buildings.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1992.
