A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE NORTH CAROLINA MUSEUM OF
ART FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND LANDSCAPING.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North Carolina Museum of Art the sum of one million seven hundred thousand dollars (\$1,700,000) for the 1992-93 fiscal year for capital improvements. One million dollars (\$1,000,000) of these funds shall be used for building repairs and renovations, including completing the brick repairs, overhauling the heating and air conditioning systems, and improvements to the electrical switching and circuit breaker systems. Seven hundred thousand dollars (\$700,000) of the funds shall be used for landscaping around the museum building.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1992.
