1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE VETERANS' AFFAIRS COMMISSION SHALL
3	ISSUE RULES FOR THE AWARDING OF THE NORTH CAROLINA
4	SERVICES MEDAL TO VETERANS WHO HAVE SERVED IN ANY WAR.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. G.S. 143B-399 reads as rewritten:
7	"§ 143B-399. Veterans' Affairs Commission – creation, powers and duties.
8	There is hereby created the Veterans' Affairs Commission of the Department of
9	Administration. The Veterans' Affairs Commission shall have the following functions
10	and duties:
11	(1) To advise the Governor on matters relating to the affairs of veterans in
12	North Carolina;
13	(2) To maintain a continuing review of the operation and budgeting of
14	existing programs for veterans and their dependents in the State and to
15	make any recommendations to the Governor for improvements and
16	additions to such matters to which the Governor shall give due
17	consideration;

1	(3) To serve collectively as a liaison between the Division of Veterans
2	Affairs and the veterans organizations represented on the Commission;
3	(4) To promulgate rules and regulations concerning the awarding of
4	scholarships for children of North Carolina veterans as provided by
5	Article 4 of Chapter 165 of the General Statutes of North Carolina.
6	The Commission shall make rules and regulations consistent with the
7	provisions of this Chapter. All rules and regulations not inconsistent
8	with the provisions of this Chapter heretofore adopted by the State
9	Board of Veterans' Affairs shall remain in full force and effect unless
10	and until repealed or superseded by action of the Veterans Affairs
11	Commission. All rules and regulations adopted by the Commission
12	shall be enforced by the Division of Veterans' Affairs; and
13	(4.1) To promulgate rules concerning the awarding of the North Carolina
14	Services Medal to all veterans who have served in any war as
15	defined in U.S.C. Title 38. The award shall be self-financing; those
16	who wish to be awarded the medal shall pay a fee to cover the
17	expenses of producing the medal and awarding the medal. All rules
18	adopted by the Commission with respect to the North Carolina
19	Services Medal shall be implemented and enforced by the Division
20	of Veterans' Affairs; and
21	(5) To advise the Governor on any matter the Governor may refer to it."
22	Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
