A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO CLARIFY AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE BOUNDARY BETWEEN  
2 THE ALAMANCE COUNTY AND BURLINGTON CITY SCHOOL  
3 ADMINISTRATIVE UNITS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. Section 3 of Chapter 166, Session Laws of 1985, reads as  
7 rewritten:

8 "Sec. 3. No sooner than nine months and no later than one year after the effective  
9 date of any annexation of additional territory to the municipal corporate boundaries of  
10 the City of Burlington, the Alamance County Board of Elections shall conduct an  
11 election by the duly qualified voters entitled to vote in a general election residing in the  
12 newly annexed territory of the City of Burlington to determine whether such territory  
13 shall remain as part of the Alamance County School Administrative Unit, or become a  
14 part of the Burlington City School Administrative Unit, and the majority of those voting  
15 in such election shall determine which administrative unit such territory shall be a part  
16 of, effective on the first day of July next following certification of the results of such  
17 election. In case the number of votes shall be equally divided, the territory shall remain  
18 in the Alamance County School Administrative Unit. Provided, however, in the event  
19 that there are not at least five voters residing within said annexed territory at the  
20 beginning of the period within which such election is to be conducted, then and in that  
21 event, the Alamance County Board of Elections shall conduct the election within a three  
22 month period after it is brought to the attention of the Alamance County Board of  
23 Elections by written petition of a qualified voter residing in such area that at least five  
24 qualified voters reside in the newly annexed territory, and provided further that in any

1 event such an election shall not be held unless there are at least five qualified voters  
2 residing in the newly annexed area within 42 months of the date of its annexation within  
3 the City of Burlington."

4           Sec. 2. Except as expressly amended by this act, Chapter 166, Session Laws  
5 of 1985, remains in full force and effect.

6           Sec. 3. This act applies to all annexations to the City of Burlington occurring  
7 on or after September 1, 1988.
