A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT HUNTING ON, FROM, OR ACROSS THE RIGHT-OF-

3 WAY OF N.C. HIGHWAY 55 AND N.C. HIGHWAY 306 IN PAMLICO 4 COUNTY.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. It is unlawful to hunt, take, or kill any wild animal or wild bird on,
7 from, or across the right-of-way of N.C. Highway 55 and N.C. Highway 306 in Pamlico
8 County.

9 Sec. 2. Violation of this act is a misdemeanor punishable for a first 10 conviction by a fine of not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) nor more than fifty dollars 11 (\$50.00) or by imprisonment not to exceed 30 days, and punishable for a second 12 conviction within three years by a fine of not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more 13 than two hundred dollars (\$200.00), or by imprisonment not to exceed 90 days, or by 14 both.

15 Sec. 3. This act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the Wildlife 16 Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by other peace officers with 17 general subject matter jurisdiction.

- 18 Sec. 4. This act applies only to Pamlico County.
- 19 Sec. 5. This act becomes effective October 1, 1991.
