1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR PERMITTEES SELLING OR GIVING
2 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO PERSONS UNDER TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF
3 AGE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 18B-302 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

7 "(j) It shall be unlawful for a permittee or his employee to knowingly sell or give
8 alcoholic beverages to any person less than 21 years old. The penalty for the first
9 violation of this subsection shall be a suspension of the permittee's permit for not less
10 than six months. The penalty for the second violation of this subsection shall be a
11 suspension of the permittee's permit for not less than one year. The penalty for the third
12 violation of this subsection shall be a permanent disqualification of that permittee from
13 receiving any other permits under this Chapter."

14 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
