AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT THE SOCIAL SERVICES COMMISSION ADOPT
RULES SETTING STATE/COUNTY SPECIAL ASSISTANCE ELIGIBILITY
FOR DOMICILIARY CARE TO CORRESPOND WITH THE RULES
DETERMINING FEDERAL MEDICAID ELIGIBILITY.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. G.S. 108A-41(c) reads as rewritten:
"(c) When determining whether a person has insufficient resources to provide a

9 reasonable subsistence compatible with decency and health, there shall be excluded 10 from consideration the person's primary place of residence and the land on which it is 11 situated, and in addition there shall be excluded real property contiguous with the person's 12 primary place of residence in which the property tax value is less than twelve thousand dollars 13 (\$12,000).-the same resources determined by the reserve and asset calculation for the 14 Federal Medicaid Program, including calculations for married persons."

15 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
